# WHAT DOES GOOD BEHAVIOUR LOOK LIKE AT CROSSLEY FIELDS?

- Think about different times of the day...
- How can we make it fair and consistent for everyone?
- Does good behaviour make learning easier?



# THE THREE RULES...

The following three rules (which are on display in your classroom and around school) will ensure good behaviour for learning

- **1. Follow instructions.**
- **2. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself (including 'accidental' throwing)**
- **3. Use positive language and actions.**

# WE WANT YOU TO SUCCEED!

## ADULTS IN SCHOOL WILL...



- Give clear instructions such as:

*“Crossley Fields stop”*

*“Year 6 stop and put your eyes on me. I want to talk to you for 2 minutes”*

*“Line up one behind the other facing the person in front of you”.*

*“Year 3 use a silent voice/partner voice/table voice/classroom voice*

- Use the same language so you can follow instructions quickly and easily
- Recognise when you have made the right choices



# CLASS WIDE REWARDS!

- When we follow instructions we can earn class wide rewards. These could lead to...

- E.g. 5 mins extra play
- Sweet treats
- Extra ICT time
- A game
- Trimtrail
- A walk around the school grounds
- Any ideas?



*There will be a clear system to follow if you choose not to follow our three rules...*



# WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF PUPILS DON'T FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS?

If you don't follow instructions these are the steps all staff will follow...

- You will start on 0 each morning, lunchtime and afternoon.
- Adults will use the same language if you are given a warning. "Dave, that's a warning. The instruction is...."
- *1<sup>st</sup> warning = a reminder which is recorded.*
- *2<sup>nd</sup> warning = 5 minutes away from the group.*
- *3<sup>rd</sup> warning = Rest of the session away from your group.*
- *4<sup>th</sup> warning = Another class for 15 minutes.*
- *5<sup>th</sup> warning = Mrs Dell or SLT and your parents informed. Work in another class for the rest of the session plus reflection time.*



# WHEN ONE WARNING ISN'T ENOUGH...

Certain actions such as:

- Deliberately hurting another child or adult
- Bad language/swearing

These will be an instant 5 warnings so Mrs Dell, SLT and your parents will be informed

- Please do not comment or ‘tell tales’ about other people’s behaviour
  - This includes other adults and parents*
