HALF TERM HOLIDAY

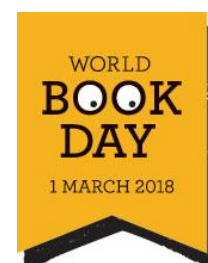
Please note school closes for the half term break on Friday 16th February and re-opens at 8.55 am on Monday 26th February.

So far we have raised just over £50. We will continue to sell toast at 10p per slice:

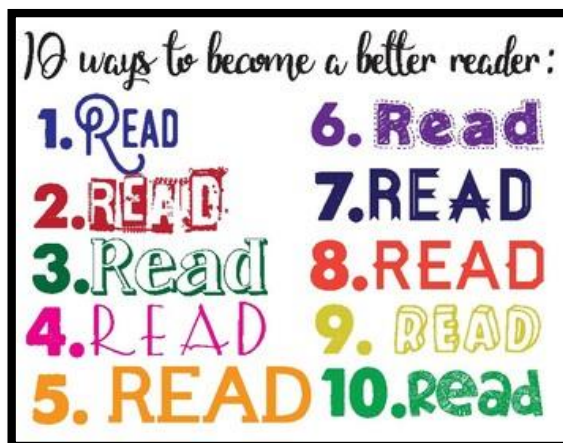
