KS2 Reading Minutes Competition

Wow! The number of minutes our children are reading for in the last 5 weeks is so impressive. The year group winners are as follows:

Year 3- 3JB with 23,573. That's enough time to read all 7 Harry Potter books 7 times!

Year 4- 4JT with 55,487. You could read all 7 Harry Potter books 15 times!
