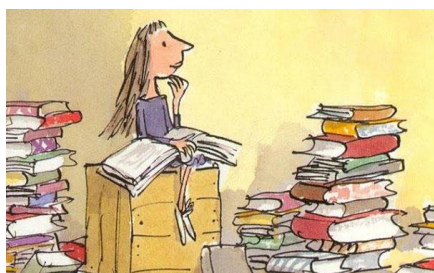
If you apply after the deadline of 31 October 2019, your application will be considered as late. Late applications are not considered until all on-time applicants have been allocated school places.
